

Alternative Dress Days (ADD) 2022-2023

Friday, September 30 – **Orange** Shirt Day (for National Truth and Reconciliation Day)

Friday, October 28 – casual but suggested theme is **fall colors**

Friday, November 18 – casual but suggested theme is **Pink** Shirt (National Anti-Bullying Awareness Week)

Friday, December 16 – casual but suggested theme is **winter holiday colors**

Friday, January 27 – casual but suggested theme is your favourite color

Tuesday, February 14 – casual but suggested theme White, **Red**, **Pink**

Wednesday, February 22 – **Pink** Shirt Day

Friday, March 17 – casual but suggested theme is **spring colors**

Wednesday, May 3 – Hats on for Mental Health (casual)

Friday, June 2 – casual but suggested theme is Pride Awareness Day (any colors on the Progressive Rainbow Flag)

Wednesday, June 28 – casual but suggested theme is **summer colors**

- Students not participating must be in uniform.
